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From the Senior
PASTOR'S Desk

Dearly beloved in Christ,

Greetings in the name of Jehovah Rapha!

By the grace of God, the Chennai Regional Conference has entered into another conference year. The 26th Session of the Regional Conference was completed on May 24th.

The Lord is good and His love endures forever. “**...I am the Lord that healeth thee**” is a powerful statement in the Bible (**Exodus 15:26**). He heals all your diseases is another positive affirmation of God in the bible (**Psalms 103:3**). On several occasions God has promised that He is our Healer. We have numerous examples of the Healing acts of God directly in the lives of the communities and individuals. Sound health and prosperity is desired by everyone on the earth. Hospitals serve as places of hope and healing to millions around the globe. However, no patient would love to be an inpatient in a hospital.

Early man believed in natural healing, and healing through natural herbs and their products. Healing in the Bible refers to physical, mental, emotional and spiritual healing. God heals from sicknesses, demonic possessions, curses and from everything man could and could not imagine in relation to his unwell condition. **The prophet Jeremiah talks about the healing of the Land through prayers and confessions. The healing of the Lord brings prosperity and strength (Jeremiah 33:1-9).**

The power of healing was experienced by the wilderness community through a branch of a Tree, a bronze serpent (**Numbers 25:1-9**) and through the throwing of some flour into the stew pot during the days of Elisha (**2 Kings 4:38-41**). **“He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed” (Isaiah 53:5).**

The power of healing was working through the Prophets, disciples, apostles and believers. **James 5:14–15: “Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.”** This verse reminds us of the power of the praying church.

Today people need three kinds of healing: Spiritual, Physical and Emotional healing. **Spiritual healing: Jeremiah 17:9** records the incurable condition of the

human heart: **"The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?"** We are sinners who have been inflicted with the disease of death and destruction and we are in desperate need of a new heart.

Physical Healing: In **2 Kings 20:5-6** we read that Hezekiah became very ill and was about to die. As a result of intense intercession, he was healed and his life was even extended. This is really an amazing account: **"This is what the LORD, the God of your father David, says: I have heard your prayer and seen your tears; I will heal you...I will add fifteen years to your life."**

Emotional Healing: Jehovah Rapha heals emotional hurts and broken hearts. **Psalm 147:3:** **"He heals the broken hearted and binds up their wounds."** The word "broken" means "to burst, to break into pieces, to crush and to smash." Some of you maybe feeling that way right now. Your emotional pain is overwhelming.

David declares that he was sick, and distressed so that he could come closer to the LORD. **"Before I was afflicted I went astray, but now I obey your word...It was good for me to be afflicted so that I might learn your decrees."** (Psalm 119:67, 71).

God bless us with sound health and Shalom.

Jesus surrendered to the father for a greater purpose to be fulfilled. Although he knew that fully well, yet there was a struggle in this submission. (Luke 22:42)

As humans we too face struggle in surrendering “OUR will to HIS.”

Here's a 3 pronged understanding .

- A) Knowing the **kingdom OF GOD**
- B) Agony in **abandoning MY will**
- C) Earnest prayer to **embrace HIS WILL**

(A) Knowing the Kingdom OF GOD- (Luke 17: 20,21)

His Kingdom is past , Present and Future. The King is Christ. The Kingdom is a state of God's Will.

When the Pharisees ask Jesus, when the Kingdom of God is coming- the image that they had in mind was a ruler who will rule ,destroy, purge, drive out, smash, demolish, destroy , scatter & condemn. Jesus' response to them in Luke 17: 20,21 – the kingdom of God is in the

midst of you. Its mercy, forgiveness, no condemnation, grace, healing, the Gentiles being welcomed, salvation, second chances, goodness & love.

The Pharisees wanted the politics of vengeance. What they got was the politics of grace. What they wanted were the observable instruments of power: rebellion, overthrow, a great hero, death to their enemies. What they got was the God who lays down His life on the cross.

My will builds my image or reputation. His will builds my character.

(B) Agony in abandoning MY will - (Luke 22:42)

Not my will, but thine be done. The Trinity is surrendering to the fathers will, abandoning his. Here **"Nevertheless"** is the hinge . We all have a strong will , nevertheless we consciously need to take the initiative to abandon our will to His will.

I can handle this- said Saul (power)

I can hide this – said David (immorality)

I am entitled to this – said Solomon (political alliances)

When we are in a place of perfectly handling everything by our own wisdom, that's exactly when we have stopped depending on the Lord and stopped growing spiritually too. We experience this in 3 seasons of a woman's life

Season 1 - YOUNG AND ENERGETIC : DINAH

stepping out into the unknown danger zone. The space that we first exercise our self will.

. . . . **THY Kingdom come, MY will be done**

Season 2 - MATURING IN SUBMISSION :LOIS & EUNICE
Paul credits them for their sincere faith, and self will that surrenders to authority yet influences & Impacts.

Season 3 - MATURED & WISE :Wise woman at Abel
She heard Joab, and then called the people of the village in her wisdom to ask a collective decision. Then she depended on the Lord for the outcome.

(C) Embracing His will - (Psalm 95:6)

PRIORITY.....Shows your preference to seek His will in every choice you make.

POSTURE.....Shows your reverence in unceasing prayer.

PINCH , PAIN..... Shows your perseverance even when it hurt you choose to obey His will.

Rendering abandonment of will is not depending on what God will do, but depending on who God is.
